

RELATIVITY FEST SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This document contains the terms and conditions (“Terms”) for kCura’s Relativity Fest student scholarship (the “Scholarship”). By submitting Your application for the Scholarship, You agree to and accept these Terms.

kCura reserves the right to modify or cancel these Terms or any portion thereof, and further reserves the right to modify or cancel any program or information described or published on the Relativity Fest or the application website without prior notice.

1. Application Criteria. To apply for the Scholarship, You must (i) be currently enrolled in an ABA accredited law school or paralegal program, or have graduated from such program in the Spring 2017 semester, (ii) complete the application form, and (iii) agree to the publicity release agreement. You must submit Your application by August 18, 2017 and must attain at least twenty-one (21) years of age on or before October 21, 2017. You must apply using Your full legal name, and must provide Your most current contact information. You are only eligible to receive the Scholarship once.

2. Acceptance. The Relativity Fest Scholarship Committee (the “Committee”) will evaluate the merits of each application that it receives, and will make the final determination to either award or deny a Scholarship in its sole and absolute discretion. The Committee will award the Scholarship to no more than ten (10) applicants. If kCura selects You as a recipient of the Scholarship, kCura will notify You of such selection in an offer letter that details the procedure for accepting or rejecting the Scholarship. You may not transfer the Scholarship for any reason, and any attempted transfer of the Scholarship will be void *ab initio*. If You do not respond to the offer letter by September 15, 2017, Your offer will be rescinded and may be extended to another applicant.

3. Scholarship Funds. The Scholarship consists of (i) complimentary Relativity Fest registration, (ii) round-trip transportation to and from Relativity Fest, (iii) hotel accommodations, and (iv) a \$100 stipend for incidentals. kCura will work with You to coordinate transportation, but will determine the details of the transportation in its sole discretion. kCura is not responsible for Scholarship funds that are lost or stolen once they have been delivered to You. You are responsible for reporting the Scholarship to the relevant taxing authorities, and for paying taxes on any taxable portion of the Scholarship to such authorities.

4. Transportation. In the event that Your transportation to Relativity Fest is rendered impracticable by an event outside of Your control, such as terrorism, riot, judicial or governmental action, labor disputes, or acts of God (each a “Force Majeure Event”), You will be responsible for arranging an alternative form of transportation, and kCura will reimburse You for the reasonable costs associated therewith. kCura is not responsible for any event that is not a Force Majeure Event and that prevents, hinders, delays or otherwise makes Your transportation to Relativity Fest impracticable or impossible.

5. Publicity. If kCura selects You as a recipient of the Scholarship, You may reference Your status as a Scholarship recipient on Your resume and in social media posts, *provided* that You may not use the kCura or Relativity trademarks, and You may not reference the Scholarship in any way that suggests or implies any affiliation, agency, endorsement, employment, partnership, or any other relationship between You and kCura.

5. Termination. kCura reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship for any reason or for no reason, in its sole discretion. The publicity release agreement will survive any such termination. If

kCura terminates the Scholarship, kCura may require You to return or repay the full amount of the Scholarship, and You hereby agree to do so.

6. Privacy Policy. kCura will respect the privacy of Your personal information that You include in Your application. kCura may, in its sole discretion, publish excerpts of Your Application on its website, at Relativity Fest, or in any other forum or format. You hereby grant to kCura any and all rights necessary for kCura to publish Your Application, and represent and warrant that you are able to transfer such rights to kCura.

7. Correspondence. All correspondence between You and kCura during the application process will be sent to the permanent mailing address listed on Your Scholarship application. You must provide Your correct and most current address, and must inform kCura of any changes in Your name or address by submitting the information via email to academic@kcure.com.
